866. SHRI VINCENT H. PALA:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated by the Government to the State Governments for implementing the Supplementary Nutrition Programme during the last ten years;
- (b) whether the State Government of Meghalaya submitted the utilisation statement for the last ten years and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the amount of rice and wheat which have been released by the Union Government to Assam during the said period;
- (d) whether the Government has taken note that one lakh bags of rice were seized from a private warehouse on Assam-Meghalaya border, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether any enquiry has been conducted in this regard and if so, the details thereof?
