STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (c) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 332 FOR ANSWER ON 21.12.2021 REGARDING COMPUTERIZATION OF GRAM PANCHAYATS IN JHARKHAND

(a) A total of Rs. 5166.71 crore has been released to the State of Jharkhand under the Central Finance Commissions Award and the schemes of the Ministry of Panchayati Raj i.e. Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) and Incentivisation of Panchayats (IoP) during 2018-19 to 2021-22 (as on 16.12.2021). Based on the information received from the Government of Jharkhand, the District-wise funds released is at **Annexure-I**.

(b) & (c) As informed by the Government of Jharkhand, of the total 4,350 Gram Panchayats in the State, 3,749 Gram Panchayats have been computerised. The district-wise details are at **Annexure-II**.
